DUE TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF PRINCIPAL INSPECTIONS ON N/M/S, THE MAINSPAN <u>SOUTH</u> ONLY WAS VISUALLY INSPECTED OVER AN INTERMITTENT PERIOD BETWEEN THE ABOVE DATES. THE GENERAL FINDINGS WERE AS FOLLOWS :

STRUCTURAL STEELWORK. : GENERALLY THE STEELWORK WAS FOUND TO BE IN A SATISFACTORY CONDITION. THE TOTAL NUMBER OF MISSING/BROKEN BOLTS ON THE SOUTH MAINSPAN ONLY, CURRENTLY STANDS AT 19 in No, COMPARED TO 18 in No. AT THE LAST INSPECTION.

**LADDER ACCESS.** : LADDER ACCESS PLATFORMS (**TOP**) LOCATED AT **P.P. 51 E & W** BOTH **N& S**, HAVE BEEN FITTED WITH NEW **ACCESS/EGRESS** GATES WHICH TOGETHER WITH EXISTING HANDRAILS HAVE BEEN PAINTED SINCE LAST INSPECTION.

**NAVIGATION LIGHT STEPS.** : BOTTOM ACCESS PLATFORMS TO B/CHORD LOCATED AT **P.P.s. 73 N&S & P.P. 101** (**WEST**) HAVE BEEN FITTED WITH NEW ACCESS/EGRESS GATES & HANDRAILS WHICH HAVE BEEN PAINTED SINCE LAST INSPECTION. WORK ON THE **EAST** PLATFORMS IS CURRENTLY ONGOING.

**PAINTWORK CORROSION.** : MEDIUM CORROSION REMAINS EVIDENT IN AS EXPECTED AREAS SUCH AS, BEAM No 1 TO STRINGERS, REDUNDANT CONDUIT, CROSSOVER SUPPORT STEELWORK, BILLETS & FIXINGS IN GENERAL.
