General Inspection Report

DATE: 11/02/2005 TO 17/03/2005

The mainspan (North & South) was visually inspected over an intermittent period between the above dates, the general findings are as follows:

<u>Structural Steelwork</u>: Generally the main structural steel members are satisfactory with no deformation evident. The missing/broken bolt status is as follows: **North 10 off. & South 18 off.**

28 off in total.

<u>Deck soffit</u>: Generally in a satisfactory condition, however, a full survey of the crossbeam & stiffener trough welds was carried out with a total of **19** locations found to have weld cracks, survey details forwarded to **E.S.M.**

The stringer billet situation remains ongoing with regard to the packing of banging billets, locations forwarded to **Maintenance inspector**, (reporting of banging billets is also ongoing on a regular basis, as and when discovered.)

<u>Grillage / barriers.</u>: Generally the grillages are satisfactory, however, the grillage handrails are now showing signs of **major corrosion**, details and locations forwarded to **E.S.M.**

<u>Paintwork</u>: Situation remains as previous reports, with remedial works ongoing at <u>Principal inspected areas</u> from <u>North tower south</u>.

<u>Electrical ducts</u>: Ducts below **inner balustade** remain as past reports, ie, missing supports / rubber joining sleeves

All defects detailed and entered on the structure report programme.
