The suspender assemblies on the side spans and main span both east & west were visually inspected over an intermittent period between the above dates. :

Where required **Optical Aid Equipment** was used for distant inspection.

**Ropes.**: Satisfactory, no strand damage visable.

<u>Top chord assemblies.</u>: Satisfactory, no movement between assembly and top chord visable.

**Spacers.**: Intact, no movement visable.

<u>Paintwork.</u>: General assembly paintwork appears satisfactory however, the rope paintwork appears to be breaking down ie, weather worn galvanised strands visable in patches throughout.

<u>Note.</u>: No access to top chord assemblies & ropes at the following main cable internal inspection areas, **PP 17-21 S/E/S/S, PP 73-77 S/W/M/S, & PP21-25 N/W/S/S.** 

All items were found to be in a satisfactory condition with no defects recorded on the structure report programme.
