## **General Inspection Report**

(BC 14) REPORT No 196. SIDE SPAN SOUTH.

DATE: 02/06/05. 30/06/05.

The Side Span South was visually inspected over an intermittent period between the above dates, general findings were as follows:

<u>Structural steelwork</u>: The structural steelwork was generally found to be in a satisfactory condition., no replacement of bolts carried out since last inspection. Total number of broken/missing bolts remain as last inspection 11 in No.

<u>Deck stiffeners</u>: End trimmer located at **pp.04 west** has an area of cracked weld approximately **750 mm** in from the kerbline ( **slow lane** ).

Roadwork signposts: Refurbishment of roadwork (pivot style) posts has now been completed.

<u>Lighting columns</u>: Lighting column at **pp.20** ( **west only** ) has been removed to allow the placement of a working platform for main cable inspection (**Faber maunsell** ) & Lighting columns **pp. 43** both **E & W** have also been removed to allow the placement of **DOC** column location seats on the top chord.

General information: Areas of surface corrosion from excessive grit residue due to applied blasting techniques used by ( **Pierse construction** ) to remove paint from top chord for column location seats at **pp. 43** ( **E &W** ) Is evident on several of the structures elements at this location. ( photographs taken & recorded on "P"drive).

On the whole, the South Side Span was found to be in a satisfactory condition, with all defects detailed & entered on the structure report programme.
