## **General Inspection Report**

(BC 14 ) REPORT No 199. SIDE SPAN SOUTH

DATE: 23/02/06 TO 19/03/06 .

The Side span south was visually inspected over an intermittent period between the above dates, general findings were as follows:

<u>Structural steelwork.</u>: The Structural steelwork was generally found to be in a satisfactory condition. No replacement of bolts carried out. Total remains as last inspection, (**11**in No).

<u>Stringer bearing wear.</u> : Continues to increase. ( As advised on Side span north report. ) End trimmer weld failure at **PP. 30 S/W.** 

<u>Paintwork / corrosion/ Bird dropping contamination.</u>:Situation continues to deteriorate as no remedial works have been carried during recent years due to no upper front or Gantry access works.

<u>Slow lane grillage.</u> : Traffic management restrictions dictate the inspection of the grillage & handrails. This will be covered by a separate survey for the whole of the suspended structure, **ie.** both side spans & main span.
