A full visual inspection was carried out out on the above date following a capital plan meeting to discuss the forthcoming replacement of the De-mag expansion joints at both the North & South towers. General findings were as follows.:

<u>Structural steelwork</u>: All structural steelwork remains intact, radius girder wear still the major concern.

Fixings.: All structural steelwork fixings remain intact, medium corrosion / paint breakdown evident.

<u>Pins bushes & springs.</u>: Situation remains as previous reports with major wear on pins & bushes, especially on the sliding plates on the main span side both north & south. Pins & bushes numbers 11,12,13 & 14 being the worst as these two plates account for most of the movement. All pins remain intact. Medium / heavy corrosion & paint breakdown evident on all springs

<u>Paintwork.</u>: Minor / medium corrosion evident throughout, loss of adhesion in certain areas of structural members. General condition no worse than previous inspections.

<u>Surface plates.</u>: Surfaces Remain As Last Inspection. Bauxite anti – skid surface beginning to show signs of wear-down on plates.
