Other duties entered the equasion as to the timescale for the completion of the main - span inspection, predominantly cable band bolt readings & inspection.. The main-span (North & South) was visually inspected over an intermittent period between the above dates, general findings were as follows.

<u>Structural steelwork.:</u> The main structural steel members remain in a satisfactory condition with no deformation/deterioration or distortion evident. Current bolt (broken / missing) status stands at **North 16 off & South 28off.** A total of **44**. Although it seems that a significant increase has occurred since last inspection, only **6 in No** are related to trusses, the others are related to top & bottom chord access hatches & apron plates. These defects will be replaced / repaired as the blasting / painting programme to top & bottom chord boxes progresses.

<u>Paintwork.</u>: remains as previous reports. No further movement on remedial works on **North upper front.** Last recorded inspection information date at current position. **19/04/05.**

<u>Billets.:</u> Full survey of current status supplied on separate survey sheet and forwarded to maintenance / manager, maintenance & paint inspector, Programme of work requires to be re-implemented.

<u>Deck stiffeners /Trough welds.</u>: No repairs carried out since last inspection. Full survey of current status supplied on separate survey sheet and forwarded to maintenance / manager , maintenance & paint inspector , Programme of work requires to be re- implemented.
