The North & South viaduct box girder internals were inspected in their entireity. Other assigned duties account for the intermittent period between the above dates, general findings were as follows.:

<u>Structurally.</u>:Generally the viaduct box girder internals were found to be in a satisfactory condition. Following report No223 & again in report No 252 stating that in the **N/E** viaduct internal the drains were previously blocked between **N2 & N5** and heavy water ingress was evident, heavy discolouration /staining remains on floor. Floor remains dry in general this inspection.

<u>Fans.</u>: S/W box girder fan (at south end) remains non- functional. All other fans both north & south functional on test at time of inspection.

<u>Lighting.</u>: Total number of lights found to be **non-functional** at time of inspection were as follows. : S/E = 4. S/W = 11. N/E = 1 & N/W = 1. a total of <u>17 in No</u>. Emergency light installation in the South box girders ongoing at time of inspection.

<u>Housekeeping.:</u> Generally debris remains throughout all box girders as previous inspections. All box girders require to be visited and all redundant materials should be removed. (Please refer to allocated individual defect sheets for locations.
