 $\mathbf{WALKWAYS}$  : GENERALLY SATISFACTORY ALLTHOUGH STILL HAVE LOOSE CLIPS & SLIGHT CORROSION THROUGHOUT .

THE SIDESPAN ON THE WHOLE WAS FOUND TO BE IN SATISFACTORY CONDITION WITH ALL DEFECTS ( 39No ) DETAILED & ENTERED ON THE STRUCTURE REPORT PROGRAMME.

NOTE. FURTHER INSPECTIONS OF THE TOP CHORD & INNER BALUSTRADE AREAS WILL BE REQUIRED IN DUE COURSE BECAUSE OF SUSPENDER REPLACEMENT WORKS ie SCAFFOLDING & HEAVY COMPONENT INSTALLATION WORKS ONGOING.
