THE MAIN SPAN WAS VISUALLY INSPECTED OVER AN INTERMITTENT PERIOD BETWEEN THE DATES ABOVE, GENERAL FINDINGS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

STRUCTURAL STEELWORK: GENERALLY THE STEELWORK WAS FOUND TO BE IN A SATISFACTORY CONDITION, WITH ONLY THE AS EXPECTED AREAS OF MINOR CORROSION & PAINT BREAKDOWN. A TOTAL OF 13 no. STEELWORK BOLTS FOUND BROKEN OR MISSING, NONE OF WHICH WERE LOCAL TO EACH OTHER.

<u>RUNWAY BEAMS</u>: MODIFICATIONS / RE-VAMP WORKS NOW COMPLETE, HOWEVER, ALONG WITH THE PREVIOUSLY REPORTED PROBLEM WITH THE SPLICE PLATE BOLTS, THERE IS NOW EVIDENCE OF SOME LOOSE LOCK NUTS, E.S.M. & M.I. DISCUSSING POSSIBLE LOCKTITE SOLUTION AND PROGRAMME.

TOP CHORD / BALLUSTRADE: THERE IS SOME DAMAGE REPORTED DUE TO THE HEAVY CONTRACTOR ACTIVITIES AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION.

THE MAIN SPAN ON THE WHOLE WAS FOUND TO BE IN A SATISFACTORY CONDITION WITH ALL DEFECTS DETAILED AND ENTERED ON THE STRUCTURE PROGRAMME.
