THE NORTH AND SOUTH VIADUCT INTERNALS WERE VISUALLY INSPECTED OVER AN INTERMITTANT PERIOD BETWEEN THE ABOVE DATES, THE GENERAL FINDINGS ARE AS FOLLOWS:

STRUCTURALLY: THE BOX GIRDERS WERE FOUND TO BE IN A SATISFACTORY CONDITION, WITH ONLY 10 off REPORTED LOCATIONS OF MINOR CORROSION / PAINT BREAKDOWN.

<u>WATER INGRESS:</u> THERE ARE 2 off REPORTED LOCATIONS OF WATER INGRESS,BOTH OF WHICH,AT THE TIME OF INSPECTION WERE OF A MINOR NATURE.

<u>FANS:</u> FIVE OF THE SIX FANS CHECKED OUT OPERATIONAL. THE S.W. ABUTMENT FAN DID NOT WORK ON TEST.

NOTE: ADVISED BY E.S.M. LAST INSPECTION, THAT THE SOUTH ABUTMENT FANS ARE CURRENTLY BEING LEFT SWITCHED **OFF**, (NOISE POLLUTION PROBLEM), **HOWEVER**, THERE IS NOW EVIDENCE OF CONDENSATION AT BOTH THE S.E. & S.W. ABUTMENT ENDS.
