STRUCTURAL STEELWORK: IN THE MAIN WAS FOUND TO BE IN A SATISFACTORY CONDITION WITH ONLY 6 BOLTS MISSING OR BROKEN. (NONE LOCAL TO EACH OTHER). VARIOUS AS EXPECTED AREAS OF MINOR CORROSION & PAINT BREAKDOWN.

WALKWAYS: LOOSE CLIP PROBLEM STILL OUTSTANDING.

THE SIDESPAN ON THE WHOLE WAS FOUND TO BE IN A SATISFACTORY CONDITION, WITH ALL DEFECTS (46 in No) DETAILED AND ENTERED ON THE STRUCTURE REPORT PROGRAMME.

NOTE: CONTRACTORS ARE CURRENTLY PAINTING THE HANGER CABLE BRACKETS ON THE TOP CHORD.
