PAINTWORK / CORROSION.: MEDIUM CORROSION REMAINS EVIDENT IN AS EXPECTED AREAS. i.e. BEAM No I. TO STRINGERS, REDUNDANT CONDUITS, FIXINGS IN GENERAL, CROSSOVER SUPPORT STEELWORK & BILLETS IN GENERAL
